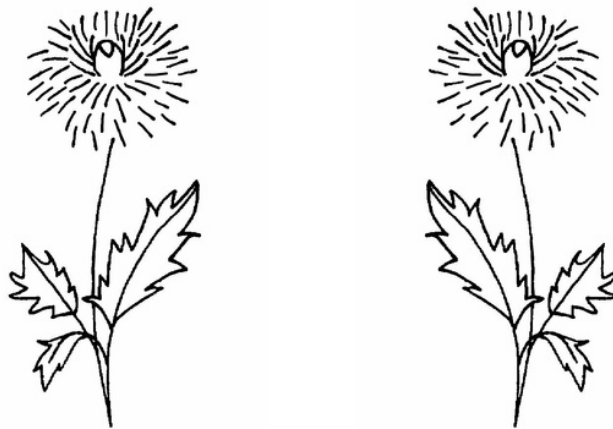




# 2023 Floral Bunting Stitch Along

## November - Cheery Chrysanthemum



### Petals:

The petals are all worked with 2 s. lazy-daisy stitches. Work in rows, building the flower as you go, and vary between using #922, #402, and #3825. The dashes are there to give you an idea of where to place your petals, but each flower will look a little different.

Tuck the stitches close to each other and add more where you feel there is too much space between petals.

### Stem:

#3012 (2 s.) stem stitch. I suggest working the stems after you've filled the leaves.

### Flower Center:

Start by outlining the top part with 2 s. #3776 and split stitch, then fill with vertical satin stitch. Stitch the bottom part (the larger part) the same way, but with 2 s. #922.

### Leaves:

Fill with 1 s. #3013 and long & short stitch (outline each leaf first with split stitch). Work the central veins with 2 s. #3012 and stem stitch, blending into the main stem.



\*s. = number of floss strands to use.
